- Volunteers should look presentable and be polite, courteous and respectful to everyone
- All volunteers must fill out a Volunteer Application Form (available online as well) and provide two references.
- Volunteers should be aware that should they feel uncomfortable at any time, or have any other questions or concerns, that they are always more than welcome to talk to the Volunteer Coordinator or the staff member in charge. She or he will do their best to solve the problem for you.

- and will only be used for the sole purpose of contacting the individual for volunteer shifts or general volunteer updates.
